Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to include Transport Cleaning Services, NSW Trains and Sydney Trains in the list of employers in Schedule 1 to the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987*. This will enable employees of Transport Cleaning Services, NSW Trains and Sydney Trains to continue to contribute to the superannuation fund under that Act if they were employees for the purposes of that fund immediately before becoming employees of Transport Cleaning Services, NSW Trains or Sydney Trains.
