Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe members of staff of the Royal Botanic Gardens and Domain Trust as enforcement officers under the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997*, who can issue penalty notices for certain littering offences (under sections 145, 145A, 146A, 146B, 146C and 146E of that Act).

This Regulation is made under the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997*, including sections 226 (relating to enforcement officers) and 323 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation
