Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to exempt from the application of the *Security Industry Act 1997* certain persons who carry out certain supervisory duties connected with the responsible service of alcohol who might otherwise be subject to the Act as crowd controllers. This Regulation is made under the *Security Industry Act 1997*, including sections 6 (3) and 48 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

3 Amendment of Security Industry Regulation 2007

Schedule 1 Exempt persons

Insert at the end of the Schedule:

31 Persons who are employed or engaged for the purposes of carrying out RSA supervisory duties (within the meaning of clause 53G (5) of the *Liquor Regulation 2008*) on licensed premises (within the meaning of the *Liquor Act 2007*), but only to the extent to which the person carries out those duties and does not physically restrain or eject persons from, or prevent their entry to, such premises.
