Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase the fixed costs for recovery of certain debts and enforcement of certain judgments in the Supreme Court, the District Court and the Local Court. The fixed costs were last increased on 1 January 2009.

This Regulation is made under the *Legal Profession Act 2004*, including sections 329, 330 and 738 (the general regulation-making power).
