

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to amend the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983* to include a reference to the New South Wales Electoral Commission in Schedule 2, which will have the effect of requiring that body to keep proper books and records in relation to all of its operations and prepare an annual financial report to be submitted to the Premier and the Auditor-General. The responsibility for complying with these requirements will be transferred from the Electoral Commissioner by the operation of this Proclamation and a regulation under the Act.
