

Commencement Proclamation


Marine Safety Act 1998 No 121

THOMAS FREDERICK BATHURST, Lieutenant-Governor

I, the Honourable Thomas Frederick Bathurst, Lieutenant-Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 8 November 2013 as the day on which the uncommenced provisions of that Act (other than those listed below) commence:

- (a) Schedule 2 to the extent that it repeals the following:
 - (i) the Maritime Services Act 1935,
 - (ii) the Navigation Act 1901,
 - (iii) the Management of Waters and Waterside Lands Regulations-N.S.W.,
 - (iv) the Port Authority—Land Traffic Control Regulations—N.S.W.,
- (b) Schedule 3.7 [3], [5], [6], [8], [10] and [15],
- (c) clause 6 of Schedule 4.

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence certain formal provisions of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, including its long title and some headings to Parts and Schedules.
