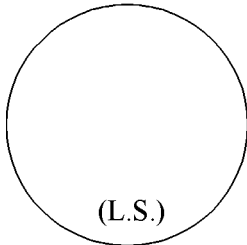
Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Amendment Act 2008 No 108

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the remaining uncommenced provisions of Schedule 1 to the *Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Amendment Act 2008*, which contain amendments to the *Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Act 1999* relating to the testing of correctional staff for steroids, in addition to alcohol and prohibited drugs.
