Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to add Murray cod (*Maccullochella peelii peelii*) to the species of fish (*indictable species*) that it is an offence to traffic in, and
- (b) to set 20 such fish as the quantity that triggers the offence of trafficking (the *indictable quantity*).

This Regulation is made under section 21A (4) of the *Fisheries Management Act 1994*.
