Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to extend by 18 months the period for restrictions on the granting of certain types of licences under the *Liquor Act 2007*, other liquor-related authorisations and development consents in relation to premises in the Oxford Street, Darlinghurst precinct (described in Schedule 5 to the *Liquor Act 2007*).

This Regulation is made under the *Liquor Act 2007*, including paragraph (b) of the definition of *freeze period* in section 47A (1).
