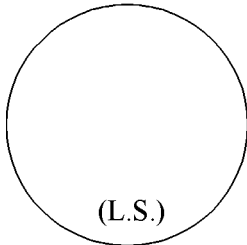

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Jury Amendment Act 2010*. These provisions amend the *Jury Act 1977* in relation to jurors, including eligibility and selection, and certain information to be supplied to the sheriff in respect of persons proposed to be summoned for jury service.
