The object of this Regulation is to increase from \$1,000 to \$50,000 the fee for an initial application for a petroleum title under the *Petroleum (Onshore) Act 1991*.

This Regulation is made under the *Petroleum (Onshore) Act 1991*, including sections 12 and 138 (the general regulation-making power).
