Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the definition of *prescribed storage tank* in clause 68 of the *Protection of the Environment Operations (Clean Air) Regulation 2010* to postpone until 1 January 2015 the requirement that certain existing petrol service stations fit storage tanks with stage one vapour recovery equipment.

This Regulation is made under the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997*, including section 323 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Protection of the Environment Operations (Clean Air) Amendment (Prescribed Storage Tanks) Regulation 2014*.
