## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to declare certain laws of other jurisdictions to be corresponding laws under the *Surveillance Devices Act 2007*.

This Regulation is made under the *Surveillance Devices Act 2007*, including the definition of *corresponding law* in section 4 (1) and section 59 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters arising under legislation that is substantially uniform or complementary with legislation of the Commonwealth or another State or Territory.

### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Surveillance Devices Regulation 2014*.

### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

### 3 Corresponding laws

The following laws of other jurisdictions are declared to be corresponding laws for the purposes of the definition of *corresponding law* in section 4 (1) of the *Surveillance Devices Act 2007*:

- (a) the *Surveillance Devices Act* of the Northern Territory,
- (b) Chapter 13 of the *Police Powers and Responsibilities Act 2000* of Queensland,
- (c) the *Police Powers (Surveillance Devices) Act 2006* of Tasmania,
- (d) the *Surveillance Devices Act 1999* of Victoria.
