## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase the fees payable under the *Electricity (Consumer Safety) Act 2004* in respect of model approval for electrical articles and for renewals, modifications and notices of change of particulars of model approvals.

The fee increases are generally in line with movements in the Consumer Price Index (rounded to the nearest dollar).

This Regulation is made under the *Electricity (Consumer Safety) Act 2004*, including section 55 (the general regulation-making power).

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Electricity (Consumer Safety) Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2014*.
