Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to include Port of Newcastle Operations Pty Limited (as trustee of the Port of Newcastle Unit Trust) in the list of employers in Schedule 1 to the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987*. This will mean that certain employees of Newcastle Port Corporation whose employment is transferred to that company will continue to be employees for the purposes of the Act.

Port of Newcastle Operations Pty Limited (as trustee of the Port of Newcastle Unit Trust), limited to those employees whose employment is transferred from Newcastle Port Corporation to Port of Newcastle Operations Pty Limited (as trustee of the Port of Newcastle Unit Trust) by order under section 16 of the *Ports Assets (Authorised Transactions) Act 2012*.
