Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe Corrective Services NSW as a law enforcement agency that may have access to applications for registration of a change of a person's name, and to entries in the Births, Deaths and Marriages Register regarding changes of names.

This Regulation is made under the *Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1995*, including sections 46A (5) (d) and 62 (the general regulation-making power).

17A Law enforcement agencies

For the purposes of section 46A (5) (d) of the Act, Corrective Services NSW within the meaning of the *Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Act 1999* is prescribed as a law enforcement agency.
