The object of this Order is to include AGL Macquarie Pty Limited in the list of employers in Schedule 1 to the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987*. This will mean that employees of Macquarie Generation whose employment is transferred to AGL Macquarie Pty Limited following the sale by Macquarie Generation to AGL Macquarie Pty Limited of the Macquarie Generation business will continue to be employees for the purposes of the Act.
