Police Amendment (Employment) Regulation 2014

under the
Police Act 1990

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to make minor amendments to the *Police Regulation 2008* as a consequence of the enactment of the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013*.

This Regulation is made under the *Police Act 1990*, including section 219 (the general regulation-making power).

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1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Police Amendment (Employment) Regulation 2014*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 24 February 2014 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Police Regulation 2008

[1] Clauses 10 and 67

Omit “regulations under the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 2002*” wherever occurring.

Insert instead “government sector employment rules under the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013*”.

[2] Clauses 10 and 67

Omit “were being considered for appointment to an officer’s position in the Public Service” wherever occurring.

Insert instead “was a Public Service employee whose engagement in a Public Service agency is subject to a health assessment”.

[3] Clause 69

Omit the clause. Insert instead:

69 Application of Public Service conditions of employment

- (1) The provisions of the regulations under the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013* that relate to the following matters apply to administrative officers and temporary employees in the same way as they apply to Public Service employees:
 - (a) public holidays,
 - (b) absence from duty,
 - (c) increments,
 - (d) fitness for duty.
- (2) For that purpose, a reference in any such provision to the Public Service Commissioner or the agency head is to be read as a reference to the Commissioner.
- (3) In the case of an administrative officer within the NSW Police Force Senior Executive Service, this clause is subject to the contract of employment under Part 5 of the Act between the officer and the Commissioner.

[4] Clause 98 Entitlement to extended leave

Omit “Schedule 3A to the *Public Sector Employment and Management Act 2002*” from clause 98 (2) (c) and (3) wherever occurring.

Insert instead “Schedule 2 to the *Government Sector Employment Regulation 2014*”.
