## Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to amend the *Public Health Act 2010* to add viral haemorrhagic fevers to the list of medical conditions in Schedule 1 to that Act:

- (a) that must be notified by medical practitioners to the Secretary of the Ministry of Health, and
- (b) for which the Secretary of the Ministry of Health may direct a person to undergo medical examination, and
- (c) for which an authorised medical practitioner may make a public health order.

This Order is made under section 51 (2) of the *Public Health Act 2010*.
