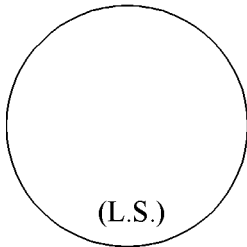
Cemeteries and Crematoria Act 2013 No 105
