

- I, General The Honourable David Hurley AC DSC, Governor of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Amendment Act 2014*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 November 2014 as the day on which the following provisions of that Act commence:
- (a) the long title and sections 1 and 2,
- (b) Schedule 2,
- (c) Schedule 5 (except Schedule 5.4).

## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the machinery provisions of the *Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Amendment Act 2014* and other provisions of that Act that substitute Part 15 of the *Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Act 2002* (relating to safeguards applying to the exercise of police powers) and that make consequential amendments to that Act and other legislation.

This Proclamation is made under section 2 of the Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Amendment Act 2014.
