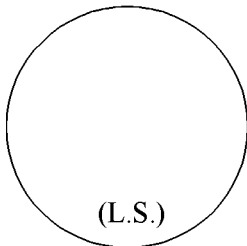

- (c) Schedule 5 (except Schedule 5.4).

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the machinery provisions of the *Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Amendment Act 2014* and other provisions of that Act that substitute Part 15 of the *Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Act 2002* (relating to safeguards applying to the exercise of police powers) and that make consequential amendments to that Act and other legislation.

This Proclamation is made under section 2 of the *Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Amendment Act 2014*.
