Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe as an *officer of an authority* for the purposes of the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983*, a statutory officer who is not a Public Service employee under the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013* but who is the head of, or exercises functions in relation to, a Public Service agency.

This Regulation is made under the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983*, including the definition of *officer of an authority* in section 4 (1) and section 64 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

- (c) a statutory officer who is not a Public Service employee under the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013* but who is the head of, or exercises functions in relation to, a Public Service agency under that Act is prescribed in relation to that agency.
