

Commencement Proclamation



Passenger Transport Act 2014 No 46

- I, General The Honourable David Hurley AC DSC, Governor of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Passenger Transport Act* 2014, do, by this my Proclamation:
- (a) appoint 1 December 2014 as the day on which the following provisions of that Act commence:
 - (i) Part 1 (other than section 7),
 - (ii) Part 9,
 - (iii) Part 10 (other than sections 173 and 179),
 - (iv) Parts 2 and 3 of Schedule 1,
 - (v) Schedule 2,
 - (vi) clauses 1–3, 10 and 15 of Schedule 3, and
- (b) appoint 12 December 2014 as the day on which Divisions 1, 2 and 3 of Part 7 of, and clause 12 of Schedule 3 to, that Act commence.
