Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Road Transport (General) Regulation 2013* to prescribe the standing of an unregistered trailer on a road as a penalty notice offence.

This Regulation is made under the *Road Transport Act 2013*, including sections 23 (the general regulation-making power) and 195.
