Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence a provision of the *Work Health and Safety (Mines) Act 2013* that validates certain regulatory functions exercised in respect of coal mining lease areas. That validation provision was inserted in the *Work Health and Safety (Mines) Act 2013* by the *Work Health and Safety (Mines) Amendment Act 2014*. This Proclamation also commences a provision that defines a term used in that validation provision.
