# Water Management (General) Amendment (Anabranched Water) Regulation 2014

under the

Water Management Act 2000

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Water Management Act 2000*.

## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to extend until 30 June 2015 the exemption of Anabranched Water (being the private irrigation board for the Great Anabranched of the Darling River Private Water Supply and Irrigation District) from the requirement that it must not serve a notice of a proposed take over of an existing water supply work after the expiration of 12 months after the constitution of its private irrigation district or on any person in respect of work that belongs to, or is under the control or management of, a public authority.

This Regulation is made under the *Water Management Act 2000*, including section 400 (the general regulation-making power).

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Water Management (General) Amendment (Anabranh Water) Regulation 2014*.

#### **Clause 226C Exemptions relating to taking over works—Anabranh Water**
