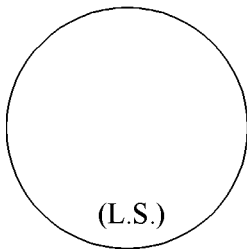

- (e) Schedule 1.10 [5]–[7], [15]–[19], [22], [23] and [26],
- (f) Schedule 1.14 [2],
- (g) Schedule 3.1.

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments to the *Water Management Act 2000* relating to the following matters:

- (b) supplementary water access licences,
- (c) harvestable rights,

- (d) controlled allocation of access licences,
- (e) metering requirements,
- (f) offences involving the taking of water,
- (g) authorisation to take water from uncontrolled flows,
- (h) streamlining of licensing and trading processes,
- (i) management plans,
- (j) combined approvals,
- (k) floodplain harvesting access licences.
