Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe a fee of \$89 for the issue of a 10-year Photo Card. (Currently Photo Cards are issued for 5 years, for a fee of \$50.)

This Regulation is made under the *Photo Card Act 2005*, including sections 5 (3) and 36 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Photo Card Amendment (Fee for 10-Year Card) Regulation 2015*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 16 March 2015 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

Clause 4 Fee for Photo Card

Omit clause 4 (a). Insert instead:

- (a) in the case of a new 10-year Photo Card—\$89, or
- (a1) in the case of a new 5-year Photo Card—\$50, or
