Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Gas Supply (Consumer Safety) Regulation 2012* to increase the fees payable in connection with the examination and testing of gas meters.

The fee increases are generally in line with movements in the Consumer Price Index (rounded to the nearest dollar).

This Regulation is made under the *Gas Supply Act 1996*, including sections 83 (the general regulation-making power) and 83A (f) and (g).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Gas Supply (Consumer Safety) Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2015*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 July 2015 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.
