Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to enable the Chief Executive Officer of Service NSW to sub-delegate customer service functions to local councils, county councils and registrars of the Local Court.

This Regulation is made under the Service NSW (One-stop Access to Government Services) Act 2013, including sections 7 (3) (b) and 21 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Service NSW (One-stop Access to Government Services) Amendment (Delegation) Regulation 2015.

2 Commencement

Clause 5

Insert after clause 4:

5 Sub-delegation of customer service functions by CEO

Each of the following is prescribed for the purposes of section 7 (3) (b) of the Act:

- (a) a council or county council within the meaning of the *Local Government Act 1993*,
- (b) a registrar of the Local Court.
