

# Real Property Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2015

under the

Real Property Act 1900

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Real Property Act 1900*.

## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to increase certain fees payable to the Registrar-General under the *Real Property Act 1900*. The fee increases are generally in line with movements in the Consumer Price Index. This Regulation is made under the *Real Property Act 1900*, including sections 96B (1), 96J (a), 115 (1), 115A (1), 116, 135D (1) (c) and 144 (the general regulation-making power).

## 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Real Property Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2015.

#### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 July 2015 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.
