1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Public Holidays Amendment (Walcha Council and Shoalhaven City Council) Order 2015*.

3 Amendment of Public Holidays Order 2011

Omit clause 3. Insert instead:

3 Public holidays for a specified part of the State

For the purposes of section 5 (1) of the Act, a day or part-day specified in Column 2 is declared to be a public holiday for the part of the State specified in Column 1:

Column 1	Column 2
Walcha Council area	Part-day from 12 midday to 6 pm on 6 February 2015
That part of the County of Camden, the Parish of Cambewarra and those portions of the Parishes of Burrawang, Bugong, Yarrawa and Wallawa that are situated within the Shoalhaven City Council area	Part-day from 9 am to 5 pm on 13 February 2015
