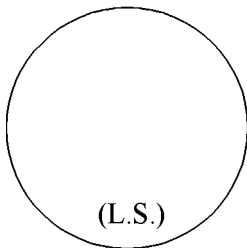
Health Practitioner Regulation Legislation Amendment Act 2014 No 84

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Health Practitioner Regulation Legislation Amendment Act 2014*. Those provisions amend the following Acts:

- (a) the *Health Practitioner Regulation (Adoption of National Law) Act 2009*, including in relation to critical impairment conditions and notification requirements for Councils for health professionals,
- (b) the *Health Services Act 1997* and the *Private Health Facilities Act 2007*, in relation to the sharing of information between public health organisations and licensees of private health facilities.
