1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Administrative Arrangements (Administrative Changes—Liquor and Gaming) Order 2015*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Abolition of Independent Liquor and Gaming Authority Staff Agency

- (1) The persons employed in the Independent Liquor and Gaming Authority Staff Agency are transferred to the Department of Justice.
- (2) The Independent Liquor and Gaming Authority Staff Agency is abolished.
- (3) A reference in any Act or statutory or other instrument, or in any contract or agreement, to the Independent Liquor and Gaming Authority Staff Agency is to be construed as a reference to the Department of Justice.
