Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Motor Accidents (Lifetime Care and Support) Regulation 2015* to authorise the appointed directors of the board of Insurance and Care NSW as a class of persons to whom the Lifetime Care and Support Authority of New South Wales may delegate any of its functions.

This Regulation is made under the *Motor Accidents (Lifetime Care and Support) Act 2006*, including paragraph (b) of the definition of **authorised person** in section 41 (2) and section 63 (the general regulation-making power).

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1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Motor Accidents (Lifetime Care and Support) Amendment (Delegation) Regulation 2015*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

Insert after clause 4:

5 Delegation to authorised persons

The appointed directors of the ICNSW Board (within the meaning of the *State Insurance and Care Governance Act 2015*) are authorised as a class of persons for the purposes of section 41 of the Act.
