His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Sporting Injuries Insurance Act 1978*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Sporting Injuries Insurance Regulation 2014* to authorise the appointed directors of the board of Insurance and Care NSW as a class of persons to whom the Sporting Injuries Compensation Authority may delegate any of its functions.

This Regulation is made under the *Sporting Injuries Insurance Act 1978*, including paragraph (b) of the definition of *authorised person* in section 10 (2) and section 30 (the general regulation-making power).

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1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Sporting Injuries Insurance Amendment (Delegation) Regulation 2015*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Sporting Injuries Insurance Regulation 2014

6A Delegation to authorised persons

The appointed directors of the ICNSW Board (within the meaning of the *State Insurance and Care Governance Act 2015*) are authorised as a class of persons for the purposes of section 10 of the Act.
