Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Regulation 2013* to authorise the appointed directors of the board of Insurance and Care NSW as a class of persons to whom the Workers Compensation (Dust Diseases) Authority may delegate any of its functions.

This Regulation is made under the *Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act 1942*, including paragraph (b) of the definition of **authorised person** in section 5AB (2) and section 10 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

5A Delegation to authorised persons

The appointed directors of the ICNSW Board (within the meaning of the *State Insurance and Care Governance Act 2015*) are authorised as a class of persons for the purposes of section 5AB of the Act.
