Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to include AGL Energy Limited in the list of employers in Schedule 1 to the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987*. This will mean that employees of AGL Energy Limited who were employees of AGL Macquarie Pty Limited (for the purpose of that Act) immediately before commencing employment with AGL Energy Limited will continue to be employees for the purposes of that Act.

Insert at the end of Part 1:

AGL Energy Limited, limited to those employees who, immediately before commencing employment with AGL Energy Limited, were:

- (a) employees of AGL Macquarie Pty Limited, and
- (b) employees for the purposes of this Act.
