Electricity Supply (General) Amendment (Delta Electricity) Regulation 2015

under the

Electricity Supply Act 1995

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Electricity Supply Act 1995*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Electricity Supply (General) Regulation 2014* as follows:

- (a) to specify Sunset Power International Pty Ltd (the new owner of Delta Electricity) instead of Delta Electricity as a direct supplier of electricity who is required to participate in the energy savings scheme under the *Electricity Supply Act 1995*,
- (b) to replace a reference to Delta Electricity with a reference to Sunset Power International Pty Ltd for the purpose of identifying the liable acquisitions that are applicable to Sunset Power International Pty Ltd for calculating its individual energy savings target under the energy savings scheme.

This Regulation is made under the *Electricity Supply Act 1995*, including sections 101 (2), 107 (2) (b) and 191 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Electricity Supply (General) Amendment (Delta Electricity) Regulation 2015*.

2 Commencement

3 Amendment of Electricity Supply (General) Regulation 2014

Clause 29 Direct suppliers of electricity

Omit “Delta Electricity” wherever occurring.
