Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *National Energy Retail Law (Adoption) Regulation 2013* to confer the current exemption for Delta Electricity from the *National Energy Retail Law (NSW)*, relating to the BHP Port Kembla Slab and Plate Products Contract, on Sunset Power International Pty Ltd (the new owner of Delta Electricity).

This Regulation is made under the *National Energy Retail Law (Adoption) Act 2012*, including section 12 (the general regulation-making power), and under section 3B of the *National Energy Retail Law (NSW)*.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *National Energy Retail Law (Adoption) Amendment (Delta Electricity) Regulation 2015*.
