Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Health Legislation Amendment Act 2015*. These provisions amend:

- (a) the *Public Health Act 2010* in relation to the installation, operation and maintenance of regulated systems for the control of legionella, and
- (b) the *Public Health (Tobacco) Act 2008* in relation to tobacco packaging and obtaining or selling tobacco products by wholesale.
