Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the provision of the *Regulatory Reform and Other Legislative Repeals Act 2015* that repeals the *West Scholarships Act 1930*. Consequent on that repeal, Part 15 of Schedule 3 to the *Education Act 1990* (as inserted by Schedule 3.2 to the *Regulatory Reform and Other Legislative Repeals Act 2015*) dissolves the Trust administered by the West Scholarships Trustees and the trust assets, trust rights and trust liabilities are transferred to the Crown.
