

# Mental Health Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2016

under the

Mental Health Act 2007

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Mental Health Act 2007*.

### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Mental Health Regulation 2013:

- (a) to increase (from \$98 to \$100) the fees payable in relation to an application for a licence for a private mental health facility and the annual licence for such a facility, and
- (b) to increase (from \$49 to \$50) the fee payable for a duplicate licence for such a facility.

This Regulation is made under the *Mental Health Act 2007*, including sections 115 (2) (b), 118 (b), 119 and 196 (the general regulation-making power).
