Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to enable the State Insurance Regulatory Authority and its chief executive to delegate functions under the *State Insurance and Care Governance Act 2015* to Public Service employees and statutory officers.

This Regulation is made under the *State Insurance and Care Governance Act 2015*, including sections 26 and 30 (the general regulation-making power).

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1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *State Insurance and Care Governance Amendment (Delegation) Regulation 2016*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of State Insurance and Care Governance Regulation 2015

Clause 5

Insert after clause 4:

5 Authorised person

The following are prescribed as an authorised person for the purposes of section 26 of the Act:

- (a) a Public Service employee within the meaning of the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013*,
- (b) a statutory officer.
