

# Environmental Planning and Assessment Amendment (Loose-fill Asbestos Insulation) Regulation 2016

under the

**Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979** 

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to require a planning certificate relating to land that includes residential premises listed on the register under Division 1A of Part 8 of the *Home Building Act 1989* to include a statement that the premises are listed on that register. That register lists residential premises that contain or have contained loose-fill asbestos insulation.

This Regulation is made under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, including sections 149 (2) and 157 (the general regulation-making power).

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#### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Amendment* (Loose-fill Asbestos Insulation) Regulation 2016.

#### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 20 June 2016 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

## 3 Amendment of Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2000 Schedule 4 Planning certificates

Insert after clause 19:

#### 20 Loose-fill asbestos insulation

If the land includes any residential premises (within the meaning of Division 1A of Part 8 of the *Home Building Act 1989*) that are listed on the register that is required to be maintained under that Division, a statement to that effect.
