

Conveyancing (General) Amendment (Miscellaneous) Regulation 2016

under the

Conveyancing Act 1919

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Conveyancing Act 1919*.

Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to prescribe Kooragang Water Pty Ltd as a prescribed authority for the purposes of section 88A of the *Conveyancing Act 1919* so that an easement without a dominant tenement may be created in favour of that corporation if the easement is for the purpose of, or incidental to, the supply of a utility service to the public, and
- (b) to remove a specific reference to the use of facsimiles as a means by which requests for public searches of registers under that Act may be lodged.

This Regulation is made under the *Conveyancing Act 1919*, including sections 88A, 199 and 202 (the general regulation-making power).

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1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Conveyancing (General) Amendment (Miscellaneous) Regulation 2016.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

Omit ", facsimile" from clause 41 (b).

Insert after clause 49 (1) (ag):
