Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to increase the fees for Photo Cards, and
- (b) to increase the penalties for offences dealt with by way of a penalty notice issued under the *Photo Card Act 2005*.

The increases are generally in line with movements in the Consumer Price Index.

This Regulation is made under the *Photo Card Act 2005*, including sections 5 (3), 34 and 36 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Photo Card Amendment (Fees and Penalty Notice Offences) Regulation 2016*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 July 2016 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.
