Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Real Property Regulation 2014* to remove specific references to the use of facsimiles as a means by which requisitions for official searches of the Register may be lodged. This Regulation is made under the *Real Property Act 1900*, including sections 96B, 96C, 96G and 144 (the general regulation-making power).
