Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to update certain fees and deposits payable under the *Surveying and Spatial Information Act 2002*, and
- (b) to prescribe a new fee relating to applications for mutual recognition.

This Regulation is made under the *Surveying and Spatial Information Act 2002*, including section 36 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Surveying and Spatial Information Amendment (Fees and Deposits) Regulation 2016*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 July 2016 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.
